The colored picture is the only one located that shows the farm from near the barn after I-65 has opened. The barn is just to the left in this picture. The concrete/stone from the old barn is visible just over the top of the board fence, to the right of center. This barn was located to the left and down from where the cattle are laying. The interstate [or north bound exit] is visible to the left and a semi can be seen behind the tree on the right. This picture must have been taken in the 1970's.

In the bottom picture, taken in the 1940's. The I-65 cut, form right to left in this picture would be just above the old barn wreckage and going between the horse and the cows. I believe that it is Bee behind the horse and Bud in middle right...but am not sure. In this black and white photo the trees in the background are the ones in the color photo. The trees in between were removed for the interstate. The left hand animal is just off, to the right, of an old drive.
