Grand Champion Steer Trophy to Ted Hunt, 10

County Fair 4-H Reserve Champion Trophy
To Jay Pershing, 17—Cattle Auction Is Set;
Cattle, Hogs and Poultry Placed.

Ted Hunt's 1,100-pound Hereford steer, Sox III, won grand champion honors at the Tippecanoe county fair. The 10-year-old 4-H'er, son of Mr. and Mrs. Herschel Hunt, Tippecanoe township, by virtue of receiving the county award Tuesday night, won the right to exhibit Sox III at the state fair.

◆ This is the second consecutive year a member of the Hunt family has shown a grand champion steer at the local fair. Ted's brother, Bud, showed last year's grand champion steer here, which went on to capture the state reserve grand championship.

Young Ted will be a sixth grader in West Lafayette Junior high school this fall. The winning steer, born Feb. 26, 1948, was sired by

Sox Osterhoff's Rupert Mixer III, at Ambia, and was purchased from Osterhoff last December, when it weighed 710 pounds.
